Biographical Sketch

Cal V. Hoffman

Being born in 1954, I am part of what is called the “Baby Boom Generation.” Having two other brothers and two sisters made our family large according to today’s standards. Although I was born in Albany, Texas, I grew up in rural Central Texas, living for 11 years in Hamilton and seven years in McGregor. Upon graduation from McGregor High School in 1972, I began attending Texas Tech University. While in Lubbock, I met Gena Sedgwick, my future wife. Toward the end of my junior year, I began searching for God’s direction regarding my vocation. God closed some doors and opened others. My call to the ordained ministry occurred over a two-year period, which included a year’s stay in Taiwan as a missionary after I graduated from Texas Tech in 1976. The fall of 1978 found me attending Asbury Theological Seminary. In 1979, Gena graduated from Texas Tech, and we were married in Lubbock, Texas. We spent the next three years together in Kentucky where I finished my Master’s of Divinity degree in 1982.

I returned to the Central Texas Conference where I pastored the Lorena UMC for two years. While there, I formalized my relationship with the Central Texas Conference and was ordained an elder. Also, the first of our two sons, Andrew Eugene, was born there. After Lorena, I served in Mexia as an associate pastor for 2-1/2 years, and then in Wortham for 2-1/2 years. Our second son, Kelvin Christian, was born while in Mexia. In 1989, I was appointed to serve the Hamilton UMC. It was a special blessing to return to Hamilton, where I had an opportunity to grow and renew old friendships. While serving four years in the Hamilton church, we saw our two boys grow and mature. Then in 1993, I was appointed to serve the Groesbeck UMC. We enjoyed spending four years serving in the Groesbeck church. While in Groesbeck, Gena began her own business as a legal transcriptionist (scopist). In 1997, we began five years of ministry at Edge Park UMC in Fort Worth, Texas. In 2002, we were called to pastor St. Mark UMC in Cleburne, Texas. After only two years of ministry, we were called to move to Ovilla, Texas in 2004 and pastor the Ovilla UMC for six years. In 2010, we began pastoring Richland Hills UMC in North Richland Hills, Texas and were there for 1 year and 4 months.

Andrew is now 28 years old and living in Dallas, Texas working as a video game programmer at Gearbox Software in Plano, Texas. Kelvin is 25 years old and is living in Hurst, working on the maintenance team at NRH2O while searching for a job in his field of video game and movie art.
